



Iowa 4-H Charity Shoot

Rules & Regulations

Teams of five will compete on a 12-station course with 100 targets thrown. Each shooter will be provided one box of ammo. Individuals will be responsible for all scoring. New Pioneer Gun Club staff may prevent the participation of any individual whose attire or equipment is considered unsafe.

The team with the highest score will receive prizes. Scores will be by team. In the case of a tie, an additional round will be used to determine the winners.

All participants are responsible for adhering to these rules and to the instructions of the staff responsible for the activity. All participants will be responsible for a self-assessment prior to participating in any activity, and will report any health/medication/emotional/personal issues that may impair performance. All participants will know and adhere to the following safety rules, as well as all applicable expectations of behavior. Waiver of liability must be signed by all participants. **All shooters must wear ear and eye protection.**

Please park in designated areas.

Club Shooting Rules

1. Large shot size heavy hunting loads are not allowed.
 - a. Acceptable loads are 1 1/8oz or less.
 - b. No shot larger than 7 1/2 is allowed. Only size 7 1/2, 8, 8.5, 9 or 10 are permitted.
2. If a shooter is found to be using larger shot size, they accept all liability and will defend New Pioneer Gun Club (NPCC) for action taken against them for all damages caused by this action. Shooters that do not have proper target ammunition, as defined above, will not be allowed to shoot on NPCT fields.
3. Load the shotgun only on/in the shooting pad/station when it is your turn. Only 2 shells may be loaded at a time
4. Shotguns must always be pointed downrange.
5. Gun actions must remain open at all times unless on a shooting station prior to calling for a target. Your gun must be emptied prior to leaving the shooting station.
6. Eye protection and ear protection are required at all times while on the shooting fields.
7. You will pick up all your empty casings prior to leaving the shooting field.

New Pioneer Gun Club SAFETY RULES:

- Eye and hearing protection required at all times while on shooting fields, even if you are just a spectator - NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Keep actions open until on station and ready to shoot
- Only one shell loaded at one time, except doubles and regular skeet
- Do not load guns until on station pad and ready to shoot
- Keep guns pointed in a safe direction
- Open actions during station changes
- Shooters are not to go beyond shooting field
- No hulls shall be picked up during organized shoots
- Pick up hulls on practice round only after round is completed
- Observe proper etiquette when shooting with others
