

2023 IOWA 4-H SCHOLARSHIPS

ALICE VAN WERT SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000.00

Provided by the endowment established by Alice Van Wert Murray, this scholarship is awarded to an Iowa 4-H member who has documented outstanding achievements and will be an ISU undergraduate next academic year.

C. J. GAUGER SCHOLARSHIP \$500.00

4-H alumni contributing to the Iowa 4-H Foundation Scholarship fund provide this scholarship in honor and memory of C. J. Gauger, former State 4-H Program Leader, to a student who has demonstrated participation in 4-H leadership programs and activities and is pursuing a degree at ISU next academic year.

CAMPBELL DETERMAN SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000.00

The Determan Family provides this scholarship for an upperclassman that has earned at least 60 hours of credit and is attending a land grant university. The awardee must be pursuing a degree in an agriculture or hospitality management field of study and have earned a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Recipients will be incoming freshmen in any higher education institution pursuing any field of study.

DELORES AND GAIL NELSON CASS COUNTY SCHOLARSHIP \$500.00

Named for Delores and Gail Nelson, long time 4-H'er supporters in Cass County, this scholarship is for a Cass County 4-H'er who has demonstrated leadership skills while in 4-H. The student must be planning to attend any Iowa 4 year college or university and will be an incoming freshman in the fall.

DEVRIES SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000.00

The DeVries 4-H Family scholarship is provided to an incoming freshman attending an accredited 4-year private school. 4-H'ers must have a minimum GPA of 3.50, raised on a family farm and have a strong work ethic.

DONALD AND RUBY GODFREY SCHOLARSHIP \$500.00

Provided by the Duroe family, the eligible applicants must reside in Buchanan, Benton, Black Hawk, Bremer, Clayton, Delaware, Fayette or Linn County. The recipient must be attending ISU or any Iowa community college pursuing a degree in agriculture or ag business.

DUROE AGR SCHOLARSHIP \$1,300.00

Applicants must document participation in the 4-H Communication project/program. The student must be attending ISU, UNI or U of I pursuing a four-year degree in any field of study.

HARDING-ROTH SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000.00

The Harding and Roth Families provide this scholarship to an eligible applicant that must document leadership and reside in Calhoun or Pocahontas County. They can be pursuing any field of study at ISU.

HERBERT AND LUCILLE BETTIS SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000.00

HILLS BANK LEADERSHIP \$1,000.00

Hills Bank and Trust Company in Hills, Iowa, provides this scholarship that is open to ALL High School Juniors. This program began in 2001. Eligible applicants must be a resident in one of following counties: Benton, Cedar, Iowa, Johnson, Keokuk, Linn, Louisa, Muscatine and Washington. The Jackson County 4-H Endowment provides this scholarship to an eligible Jackson County 4-H'er or alumni who is pursuing a higher education in any area of study at any college or university.

JESSE A. AND IRENE W. MCINTYRE SCHOLARSHIP \$500.00 *

Applicants must be an active Fremont County 4-H member and enrolling as a freshmen in the fall, attending any two or four year college university or technical school pursuing any field of study.

KISER SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000.00

4-H alumni and staff contributions in honor of Professor James Kiser's retirement provided the initial funding for the Kiser Scholarship. The Kiser family has permanently endowed this scholarship which goes to an applicant who is an outstanding 4 H horse project participant. They must attend ISU.

KRIS FISH KUHLMANN 4-H LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP \$2,500.00

The Kris Fish Kuhlmann 4-H Legacy Scholarship is for a former Iowa 4-H member to whom 4-H has significantly impacted their life and career direction. Applicants should be completing their ninth year in 4-H, in any county in Iowa. Applicants should be graduating high school seniors or an incoming freshmen attending any college or university with any major in the state of Iowa. Financial need is a strong consideration.

LA-CO CIRCLE OF CHAMPIONS SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000.00

LA-CO Industries, Inc. in Elk Grove Village, IL provides this scholarship to any college undergraduate or graduate school student attending any Iowa community college or 4-year college or university. They must be majoring in agriculture or related agricultural science major and preference is given to current college students.

LINDA S. MORRISSEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP \$3,000.00

The student must be attending ISU and they must have a major within Iowa State's College of Agriculture and Life Sciences. (\$500 grant may be available for training and project costs.)

MAHR FAMILY - VETERINARY MEDICINE SCHOLARSHIP \$5,000.00

Offered in even years, i.e. 2022, 2024

MARIE A. AND GEORGE H. BUSCH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP \$500.00

Busch provide this scholarship to an applicant who will be a sophomore, junior, or senior in the next academic year and whose permanent residence is in Butler or Bremer County. The recipient must attend an Iowa college or university and major in an agriculture or human science related field.

Applicants need to attend the University of Northern Iowa, University of Iowa, Iowa State University or any post-secondary school in those counties.
