4-H ART & DESIGN SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000 NEW this year!

The 4-H Art & Design Scholarship was created by Wendy Brock and JaneAnn Stout and is being made a reality by the generous contributions of many. This scholarship supports 4-H'ers who are planning careers in the areas of art and design. This scholarship is for an active Iowa 4-H'er from any county who will be enrolling as a first-year student at any accredited two- or four-year college, university or institute studying the arts: Visual, Design, Performing, Literary or Culinary.

ALICE VAN WERT ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided by the endowment established by Alice Van Wert Murray, this scholarship is awarded to an Iowa 4-H member who has documented outstanding achievements and will be an Iowa State University undergraduate next academic year.

C. J. GAUGER ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$500

Provided by the endowment funded through contributions in honor and memory of C. J. Gauger, former State 4-H Program Leader, this scholarship is awarded to a student who has demonstrated participation in 4-H leadership programs and activities and is pursuing a degree at Iowa State University next academic year.

CAMPBELL DETERMAN ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided by the endowment created by the Determan Family, this scholarship is for an upperclassman that is attending a land grant university and has earned at least 60 credit hours. Applicants must be pursuing a degree in an agriculture or hospitality management field of study and have earned a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Preference is given to applicants who demonstrate state 4-H activities and campus level activities while in college.

CAREER 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided by Shirley Stakey, this annual scholarship is for a former 4-H'er who will be an Iowa State University junior or senior next academic year and is studying any major in the Iowa State University College of Human Sciences.

CARL & GAYLENE LEE FAMILY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$500

These scholarships are funded annually by the Carl & Gaylene Lee family. The recipient must be a 4-H alum from Buena Vista, Cherokee, Hamilton, Ida, Monona, Plymouth or Woodbury counties with plans to attend Iowa State University majoring in agriculture. Financial need is given priority.

CAROL SCHNEIDER 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$500

This annual scholarship is given to a Plymouth County 4-H member. The recipient must be attending a two- or four-year college or university and will be a freshman in the fall semester. They may be pursuing any field of study. A GPA of 3.0 or higher is required.

CHARLES AND NEOMA WONDERLICH MEMORIAL 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$500

Funded by the Wonderlich family, this annual scholarship is for an Iowa 4-H member from Keokuk County or an Iowa 4-H'er attending Pekin Community High School, who will be attending Iowa State University in the fall of as incoming freshmen. Financial need is a consideration.

CHERYL & DR. DAVID PENCE FAMILY COMMUNICATIONS 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$500

The Pence Family provides this annual scholarship for former 4-H'ers who are residents of Delaware, Hardin, Jackson or Polk counties. Significant consideration is given to the 4-H'er who exhibits good character, high morals, good work ethic and takes an active role in their school and community. Applicants must show participation in 4-H Communication project/program. They must be attending any Iowa community college, technical school, trade school, or four-year college or university pursuing any field of study.

CHERYL & DR. DAVID PENCE FAMILY VISUAL ARTS 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$500

The Pence Family provides this scholarship to eligible applicants that are residents of Delaware, Hardin, Jackson or Polk counties. Significant consideration is given to the 4-H'er who exhibits good character, high morals, good work ethic and takes an active role in their school and community. Applicants must show participation in the 4-H Visual Arts project/program. They must be attending any Iowa community college, technical school, trade school, or four-year college or university pursuing any field of study.

COLVIN FAMILY ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided by the endowment fund created by the Colvin Family, this scholarship recognizes a 4-H'er who has taken their own road—one who has done their best to fully experience 4-H and life. Recipients must be an Iowa State University undergraduate pursuing a four-year degree in any field of study.

DARLA MERWALD MEMORIAL PASSION FOR HORSES 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided by contributions made in memory of Darla Merwald, former 4-H Horse Superintendent at the Iowa State Fair, these annual scholarships are awarded to recipients who have participated in the 4-H horse and pony project and who advocates for the horse industry. Recipients will be incoming freshmen at any higher education institution pursuing any field of study.

DELORES AND GAIL NELSON CASS COUNTY ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$500

Provided by the endowment created in honor of Delores and Gail Nelson, this scholarship is for a Cass County 4-H'er who has demonstrated leadership skills while in 4-H. The student must be planning to attend any Iowa college, university or community college and will be an incoming freshman in the fall.

DEVRIES FAMILY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

This annual scholarship is provided to an incoming freshman attending an accredited four-year, private school with a 3.5 GPA. Recipients must have been raised on a family farm and have a strong work ethic.

DONALD AND RUBY GODFREY ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$500

Provided by the endowment created in memory of Donald and Ruby Godfrey, this scholarship is for a former Iowa 4-H'er from Adams, Fremont, Mills, Montgomery, Page or Taylor counties. Applicants must be enrolled in the Iowa State University College of Agriculture and Life Sciences and show leadership and community service activities.

DUROE ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,300

This scholarship is provided through the endowment created by the Duroe family. The recipient must be attending Iowa State University or any Iowa community college pursuing a degree in agriculture or ag business.

EXCELLENCE IN VETERINARY SCIENCE 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

This annual scholarship provided by Abbey Smith Schwab and Cindy Howard, goes to a former 4-H'er who has been accepted to Iowa State University's College of Veterinary Medicine as a first year veterinary student planning to pursue mixed or large animal medicine in Iowa. Applicants need to show involvement in 4-H at club, county, and state levels.

EUGENE AND SANDRA (FLOY) TEGGATZ ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000 NEW this year!

The Eugene and Sandra (Floy) Teggatz Endowed 4-H Scholarship is made possible through the endowment created by Sandra Teggatz. The recipient will be an active 4-H'er or 4-H alum from Linn, Iowa or Cerro Gordo Counties and enrolling as an undergraduate at any accredited two- or four-year college or university in any field of study.

FIRST INTERSTATE BANK 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

These annual scholarships are provided by First Interstate Bank, formerly known as Great Western Bank, in West Des Moines. Scholarships are awarded to one male and one female who are active members in Iowa 4-H and show promise in their career plans. Each student must major within Iowa State University's College of Agriculture and Life Sciences.

GARY VINCENT MEMORIAL 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$500

This annual scholarship is for applicants attending Iowa State University pursuing an education in either Agriculture Communications or Agricultural Systems Technology.

GERALD AND WANDA CORNELIUS 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$500

This annual scholarship is open to any Jackson County 4-H alumni who is an incoming freshmen or college undergraduate attending Iowa State University pursuing any field of study.

GLEN AND MARY JO MENTE ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided through the endowment created by Glen and Mary Jo Mente, this scholarship is for a graduating high school senior who has been active in leadership roles in 4-H as well as in their school and community. Applicants must reside in Muscatine, Clinton or Cedar Counties and plan to attend Iowa State University.

GOERING COMMUNICATIONS ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,500

Provided through the endowment created by contributions made in honor of Don Goering's retirement in 1999, and in memory of Doris Goering. Applicants must document participation in the 4-H Communication project/program. The student must be attending Iowa State University, University of Northern Iowa or the University of Iowa pursuing a four-year degree in any field of study.

HARDING-ROTH ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided through the endowment created by the Harding and Roth families, this scholarship is for an eligible applicant with documented leadership who resides in Calhoun or Pocahontas counties. They can be pursuing any field of study at Iowa State University.

HERBERT AND LUCILLE BETTIS ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided through the endowment created by Lloyd and Kathryn Bettis in memory of Herbert and Lucille Bettis, this scholarship is open to a Monroe County 4-H'er or 4-H alum attending Iowa State University pursuing any field of study. Past recipients are eligible to reapply. Financial need is a priority.

HILLS BANK LEADERSHIP GRANT \$1,000

Hills Bank and Trust Company in Hills, Iowa, annually provides this leadership grant to twenty students who will be high school seniors. Eligible applicants must be a resident in one of following counties: Benton, Cedar, Iowa, Johnson, Keokuk, Linn, Louisa, Muscatine and Washington and are not required to be 4-H members. The recipients must attend a minimum of nine hours of Hills Bank sponsored leadership training during their senior year of high school and must have involvement in community service, student group activities, or work experience. They must be planning to attend any Iowa accredited college, university or community college and must have a 2.8 or higher high school GPA.

HUNT MEMORIAL ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided through the endowment created by the estate of Verle and Ellen Hunt, this scholarship is for a Marshall County 4-H member or resident who will be pursuing any field of study at Iowa State University next academic year.

IOWA BANKERS ASSOCIATION 4-H SCHOLARSHIPS \$500

These annual scholarships are given to Iowa 4-H'ers in each of the six Iowa Bankers Association regions across the state of Iowa. Recipients must plan to attend any two or four year private or public college or university in the state of Iowa.

IHBPA 4-H SCHOLARSHIPS \$1,000

These annual scholarships are provided by the Iowa Horsemen's Benevolent & Protective Association for current Iowa 4-H'ers who are high school seniors. Applicants may attend any two- or four- year institution in the state of Iowa. Preference for applicants studying an agriculture related major.

JACKSON COUNTY 4-H ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP \$500

This annual scholarship through the Jackson County 4-H Endowment is for an eligible Jackson County 4-H'er or alum who is pursuing a degree in any area of study at any college or university.

JANET DANE & FRANCIS T. DRISCOLL ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000 *NEW this year!*

The Janet Dane & Francis T. Driscoll Endowed 4-H Scholarship is made possible by the endowment established by Janet Driscoll. This scholarship is for a Johnson County 4-H'er who resides in Johnson County and has been a 4-H member for at least four years. They will also have been an active participant in communications and record keeping. Applicants will be enrolling as an undergraduate at any accredited two- or four-year college or university in Iowa in any field of study. Preference for students in need of financial support and/or who show promise as a future leader whose grades may not reflect their potential.

KISER ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided through the endowment created by contributions made in honor of Professor James Kiser's retirement, this scholarship goes to an applicant who is an outstanding 4-H horse project participant. They must attend Iowa State University.

KRIS FISH KUHLMANN 4-H LEGACY SCHOLARSHIP \$2,500

This annual scholarship is for an applicant to whom 4-H has significantly impacted their life and career direction. Applicants should be completing their ninth year in 4-H, in any county in Iowa, be a graduating high school seniors with plans to attend any college or university, with any major in the state of Iowa. Financial need is a strong consideration.

LA-CO CIRCLE OF CHAMPIONS 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

This annual scholarship is for a college undergraduate or graduate school student attending any Iowa community college or four-year college or university. They must be majoring in agriculture or related agricultural science major and preference is given to current college students.

LLOYD AND MYRTLE OBRECHT 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

This scholarship is for a 4-H alum of Mills or Shelby counties who has emphasis on leadership and citizenship activities in 4-H and at Iowa State University. The student is to be either a collegiate junior or senior in the next academic year and attending Iowa State University.

MAHR FAMILY ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP - COLLEGE OF AG AND LIFE SCIENCES \$4,000

Provided through the endowment created by the family of Marvin, Sr. and Frederica Mahr, this scholarship to a former Iowa 4-H'er, currently enrolled in the Iowa State University College of Agriculture and Life Sciences. Eligible applicants must have five or more years of Iowa 4-H membership and show evidence of leadership. The final selection is based on an interview. Applicants must submit a plan for a leadership/community service activity to be implemented during the upcoming school year, if selected for the scholarship. The student must be attending Iowa State University and they must have a major within Iowa State's College of Agriculture and Life Sciences.

MAHR FAMILY ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP - VETERINARY MEDICINE \$4,000

Provided through the endowment created by the family of Marvin, Sr. and Frederica Mahr, this scholarship to a former Iowa 4-H'er, accepted to or attending Iowa State University College of Veterinary Medicine. Eligible applicants must have five or more years of Iowa 4-H membership and show evidence of leadership. The final selection is based on an interview. Applicants must submit a plan for a leadership/community service activity to be implemented during the upcoming school year, if selected for the scholarship.

MARIE A. AND GEORGE H. BUSCH MEMORIAL \$500

The family of Marie A. and George H. Busch provide this scholarship to an applicant who will be a sophomore, junior, or senior in the next academic year and whose permanent residence is in Butler or Bremer County. The recipient must attend an Iowa college or university and major in an agriculture or human science related field.

MARION E. JEROME FOUNDATION 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$2,000

This annual scholarship was established by Candace & David Arp for one male and one female 4-H alum to attend any two or four year college. Preference is given to 4-H'ers showing financial need from Winneshiek, Howard, and Allamakee counties. 4-H'ers from Chickasaw, Fayette and Clayton counties are also eligible.

MARY ANN STUMBO MEMORIAL ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

The Barb and Keith Sexton family provides this annual scholarship for an Iowa 4-H'er who has actively participated in 4-H for at least five years. The scholarship is given to a student attending any Iowa four-year college or university. They can be pursuing any field of study.

MARY PAUL 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

This annual scholarship is for an eligible applicant that resides in Muscatine or Scott County and will be a freshman at Iowa State University in the upcoming academic year. The recipient can be pursuing any field of study. Financial need is given priority.

LISA SCHWALBE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP \$1,500

These annual scholarships were created in memory of Lisa Schwalbe and are for an incoming college freshman who are 4-H'ers from Clarke, Decatur or Ringgold Counties and with a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Applicants need to attend Iowa State University and major in agriculture or education.

NORTHWEST IOWA 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$500

This annual scholarship is for incoming college freshmen who are a resident of the following Northwest Iowa counties: Lyon, Osceola, Dickinson, Emmet, Sioux, O'Brien, Clay, Palo Alto, Plymouth, Cherokee, Buena Vista, Pocahontas, Woodbury, Ida, Sac and Calhoun. Applicants need to attend the University of Northern Iowa, University of Iowa, Iowa State University or any post-secondary school in those counties.

OSTER JOURNALISM 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,500

Provided through the endowment created by Merrill J. Oster, this scholarship is given to an applicant who will be a college sophomore, junior or senior at Iowa State University for the next academic year. The recipient must major in journalism or communication studies and provide documentation of journalism activity and skills in their application.

PALMER AND SHERYL HOLDEN ENDOWED 4-H ANIMAL SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided by the endowment created by the Palmer Holden family, this scholarship is for applicants who are former 4-H'ers and will be an incoming freshman to Iowa State University, studying animal science.

PERSINGER-ASMUS-FERRIN ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided through the endowment created by the Persinger and Asmus families, this scholarship is for applicants who have demonstrated participation in leadership, citizenship and/or communications in 4-H as well as their collegiate activities. They must be college sophomores, juniors, or seniors attending Iowa State University or UNI, pursuing any field of study other than agriculture.

PETERSON FAMILY ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided through the endowment created in honor and memory of Norman H. Peterson and Gertrude (Trudy) J. Peterson, this scholarship recognizes a former 4-H'er who has worked hard and has demonstrated a sense of adventure. The college student can be pursuing any field of study, attending any two- or four-year college or university.

PEYTON FAMILY ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided through the endowment created by the Peyton Family, this scholarship is for any former Iowa or Oklahoma 4-H member who has demonstrated 4-H participation with evidence of strong community service and leadership in 4-H and at Iowa State University or OSU. The applicant must be a sophomore, junior, senior or graduate student in the next academic year and pursuing a major in or related to agriculture with a minimum of a 3.0 GPA.

PHYLLIS J. OLSON ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$500

Provided through the endowment created in memory of Phyllis J. Olson, this scholarship is for any college undergraduate attending Iowa State University. They must have a major in food and nutrition or related curriculum. Preference is given to upper classmen.

PIC NORTH AMERICA SWINE 4-H SCHOLARSHIP I \$500

This annual scholarship is for an Iowa 4-H members who was active in the swine project area and/or interest in the swine industry. Applicants should be incoming freshmen with a high school GPA of 3.25 or above, attending any two or four year accredited school. Applicants must be pursuing an education preparing for a career in the swine industry.

PIC NORTH AMERICA SWINE 4-H SCHOLARSHIP II \$500

This annual scholarship is for an Iowa 4-H members who was active in the swine project area and/or interest in the swine industry. Applicants should be a collegiate sophomore, junior or senior with a GPA of 3.00 or above, attending any two or four year accredited school. Applicants must be pursuing an education preparing for a career in the swine industry.

RALPH AND AGNES DOSTAL 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$2,500

This annual scholarship is for Iowa State University undergraduates who have demonstrated participation in 4-H activities, community service and/or college activities. The student can pursue any field of study. Preference is given to current college students.

RALPH & DONNA DYER 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000 NEW this year!

The Ralph & Donna Dyer 4-H Scholarship is offered by the Dyer Family in memory of Ralph and Donna. This scholarship is for a resident of Marion County who is an active 4-H'er or alum. Applicants will be enrolling as an undergraduate at any accredited college or university in any field of study. Preference for a 4-H'er who showed beef cattle.

ROBERT AND HARRIET SMITH ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided through the endowment created by the children of Robert E. and Harriett J. Smith, this scholarship to an applicant who will be a freshman at Iowa State University in the next academic year and is pursuing a major in an agriculture or family and consumer sciences related field. Eligible applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher and reside in Jasper, Marshall, Story or Johnson County.

ROBERTS FAMILY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$500

This annual scholarship is given to an eligible applicant that demonstrates a need for financial assistance and provides evidence of community service. They must be a resident of or a 4-H'er in Boone, Cass, Marion, Montgomery or Story counties. They can be attending Iowa State University, UNI or Central College pursuing any field of study.

RUTH WHITE MEMORIAL 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$500

This annual scholarship is for any individual who has been a member of the Iowa 4-H program from Davis County and is interested in pursuing educational opportunities beyond High School. Youth may pursue any major at any college. Applicants must demonstrate how 4-H has significantly impacted their life and career direction.

SAND BURR INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

This annual scholarship is for a student who has completed their first semester in an industrial technology career program in the state of Iowa and is a student in good standing. Applicants must have been active in the 4-H Program in Benton County.

SAND BURR VETERINARY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$2,000

This annual scholarship is for a student who has enrolled in their first year of Veterinary School. Applicants must have been active in the 4-H Program in Benton County.

SAND BURR VETERINARY TECHNOLOGY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

This annual scholarship is for a student who has completed their first semester of any Veterinary Technician program in the state of Iowa and is a student in good standing. Applicants must have been active in the 4-H Program in Benton County.

SANDRA BLAND ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$500

Provided by the endowment established in memory of Sandy Bland, this scholarship is for a 4-H alum who participated in 4-H in Cedar, Muscatine or Scott counties and who will be an undergraduate student at any two- or four- year accredited college or university.

SCOTT AND STACE CHAPMAN MEMORIAL ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$1,000

Provided through the endowment created in memory of Scott and Stace Chapman this scholarship is for an active Iowa 4-H member from Crawford County who has participated in 4-H for a minimum of four years. Applicants must have participated in a livestock project area and a non-livestock project area for at least one year each. The recipient must be a freshman in the upcoming academic year and attending any two or four year college, university or trade school while pursuing an agricultural field of study. Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.00, and have demonstrated leadership in 4-H, school and community. Financial need given priority.

ALL-IOWA SHAVER FAMILY MEMORIAL ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$2,500

Provided by the endowment established in memory of Chuck & Kathy Shaver. This scholarship is for graduating high school seniors in the state of Iowa attending any accredited school in the U.S. that provides post high school education. Applicant may pursue any field of study and should show leadership skills in at least one extracurricular activity and a history of volunteering for a charitable organization.

STORY COUNTY SHAVER FAMILY MEMORIAL ENDOWED 4-H SCHOLARSHIP \$2,500

Provided by the endowment established in memory of Chuck & Kathy Shaver. This scholarship is for graduating high school seniors in Story County. Applicants will attend any accredited school in the U.S. that provides post high school education and pursuing any field of study. Applicants should show leadership skills in at least one extracurricular activity and a history of volunteering for a charitable organization.

ALL-IOWA SHAVER FAMILY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR CONTINUING STUDENTS \$2,500

Provided by the endowment established in memory of Chuck & Kathy Shaver. This scholarship is for a Iowa 4-H alum who has successfully completed one or more years of study (24 or more credit hours) beyond high school. Applicant should be attending any accredited school in the U.S. that provides post high school education. Applicants should show leadership skills in at least one extracurricular activity and a history of volunteering for a charitable organization.

SIGGELKOW FAMILY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP - BLACK HAWK COUNTY \$1,000

This annual scholarship, in honor of Wayne and Arnola Siggelkow, is for eligible applicants for this scholarship are active 4-H members in Black Hawk County with demonstrated academic excellence and leadership roles in 4-H as well as their school and community. The recipient must be a freshman in the upcoming academic year and attending Iowa State University while pursuing any field of study.

SIGGELKOW FAMILY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP - BREMER COUNTY \$1,000

This annual scholarship, in honor of Wayne and Arnola Siggelkow, is for eligible applicants for this scholarship are active 4-H members in Bremer County with demonstrated academic excellence and leadership roles in 4-H as well as their school and community.
